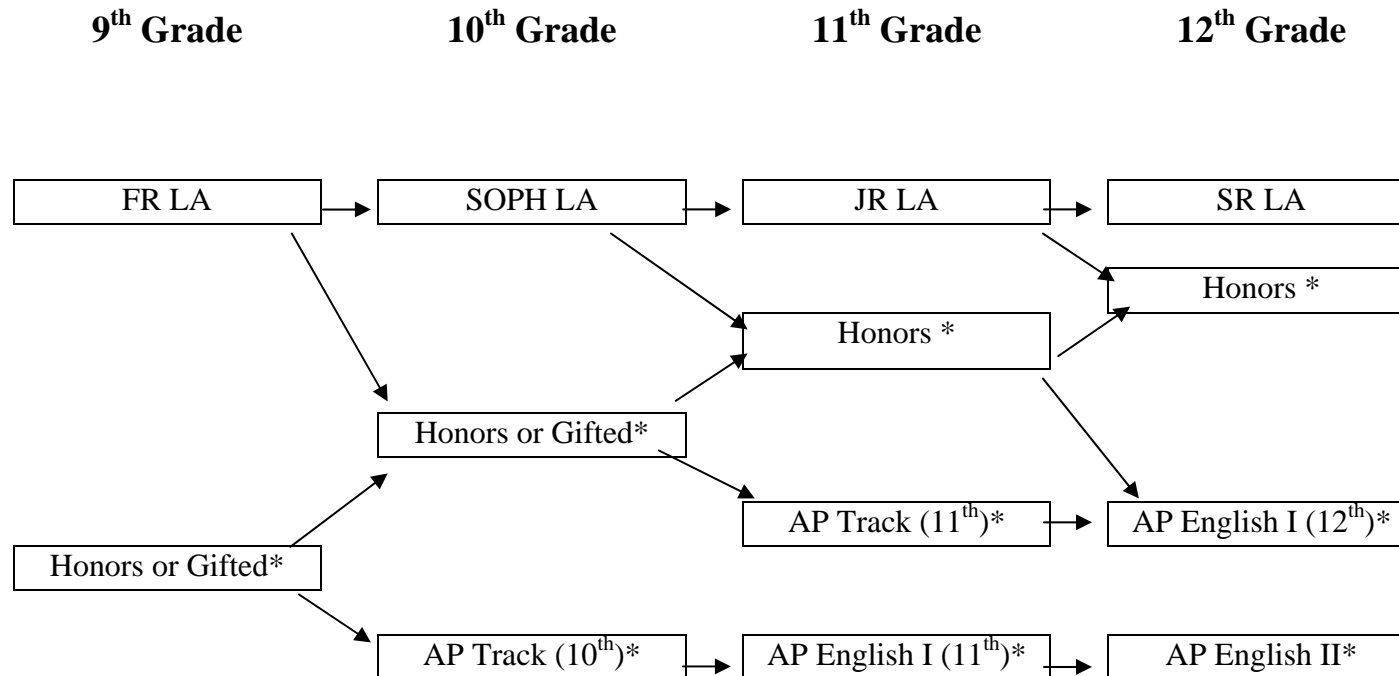


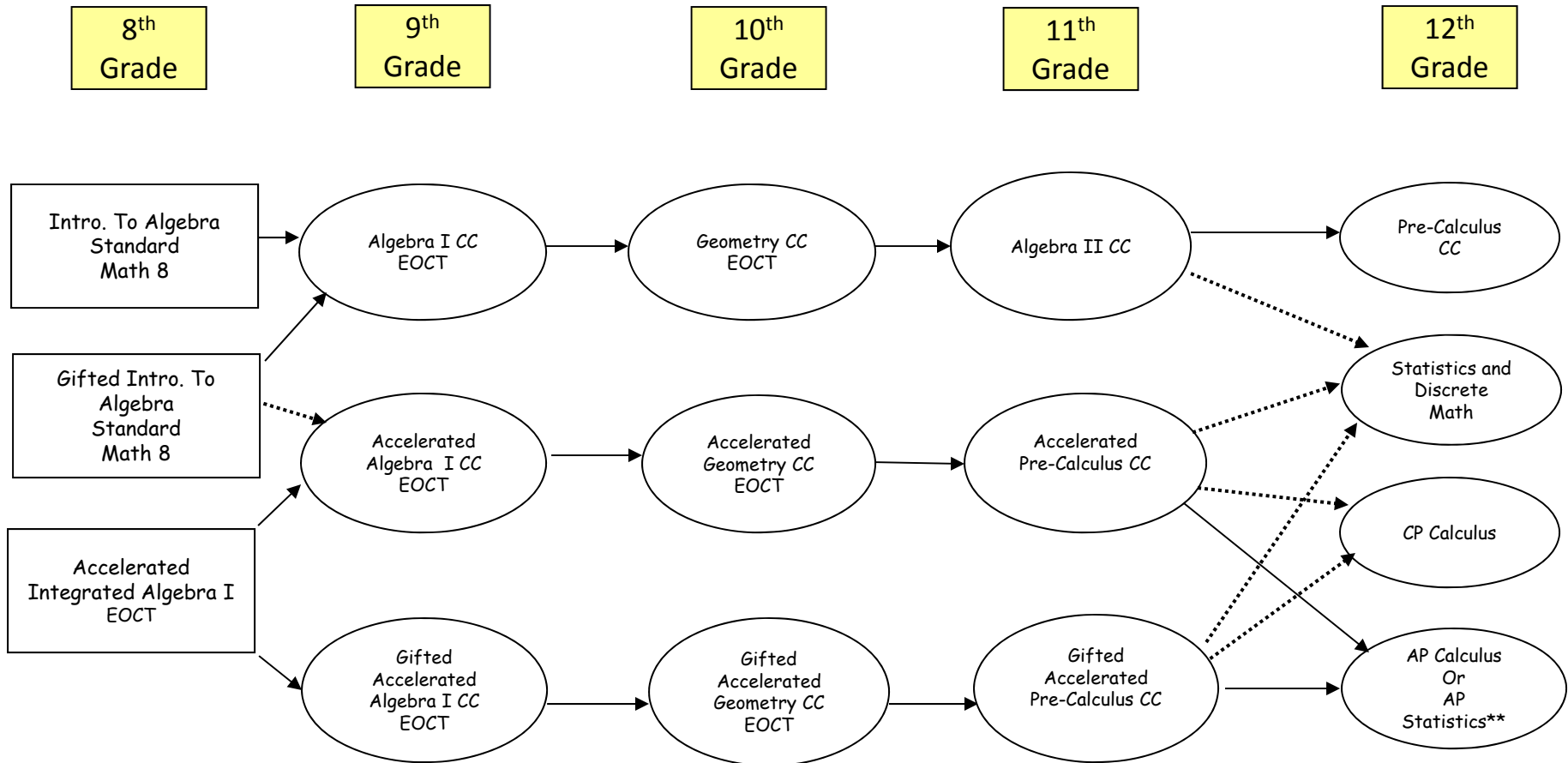
# Language Arts Department Course Sequences



Placement in all courses requires a teacher recommendation and may result in the student being placed in a new sequence.

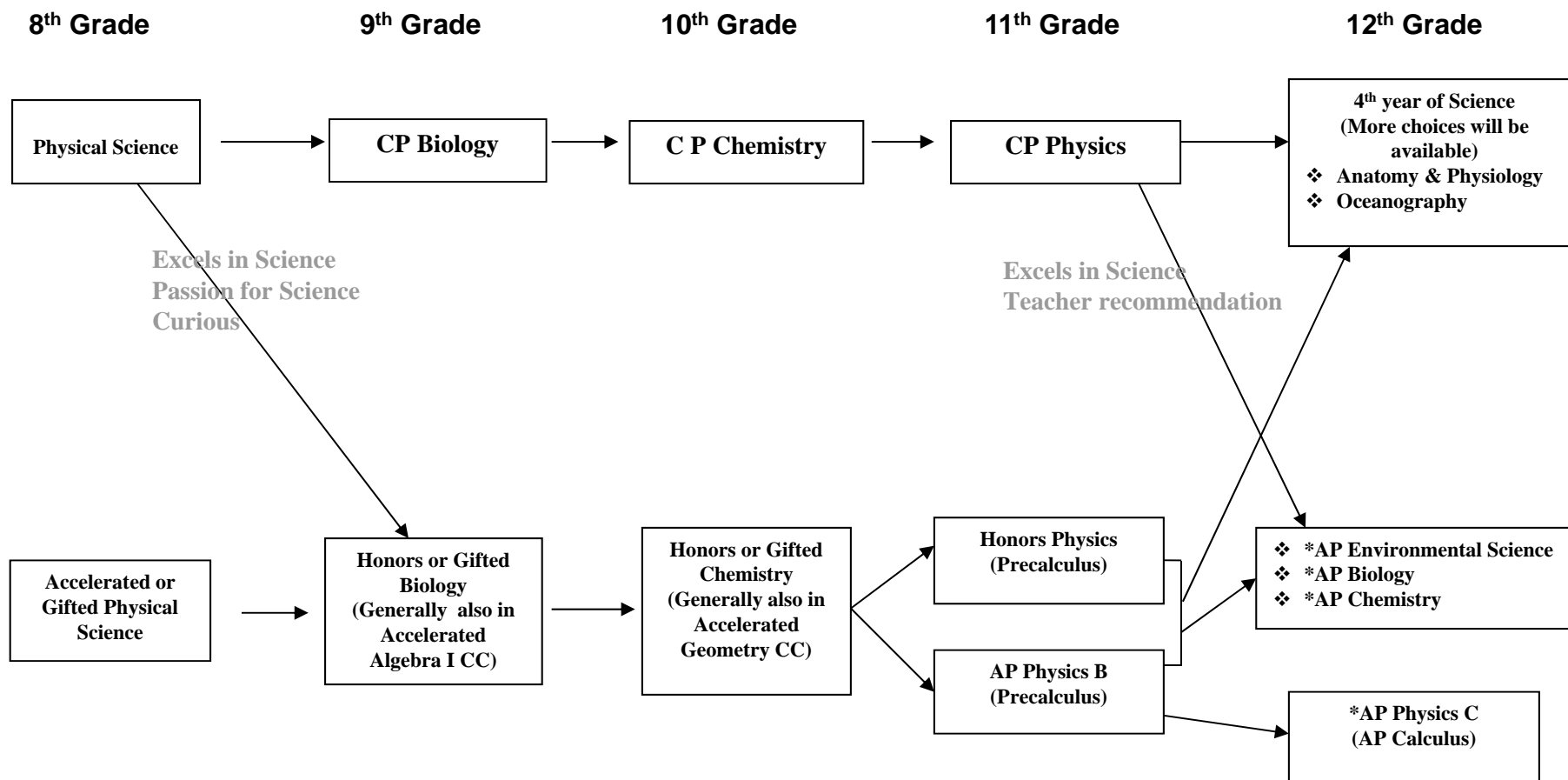
\*Placement in gifted classes or Advanced Placement courses requires acceptance into the respective program; continuation in Honors/Gifted/AP programs requires a 78 average.

## Collins Hill High School Science Course Sequence Ninth Graders Entering High School



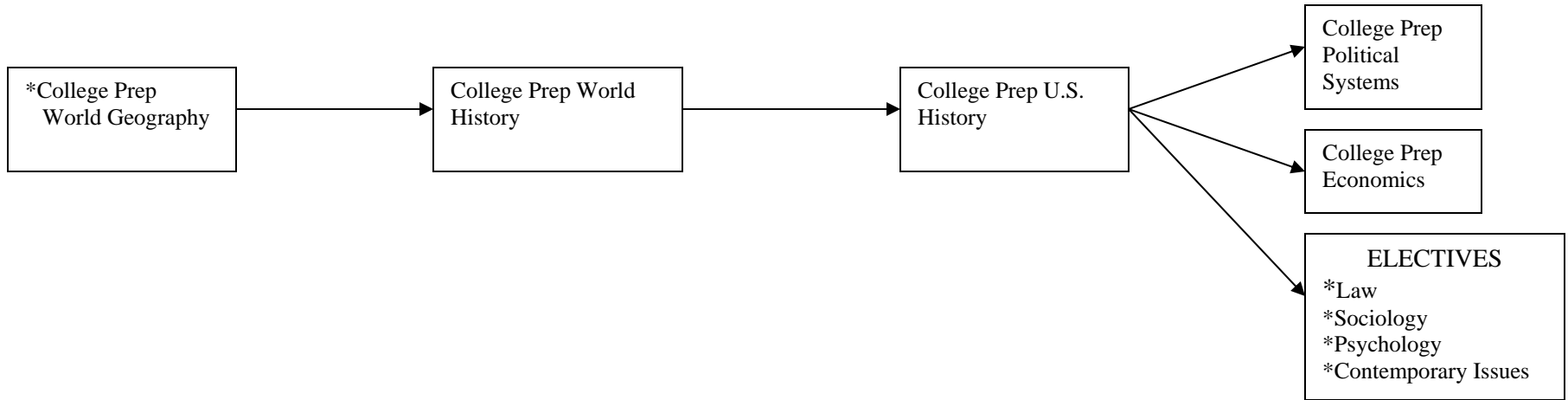

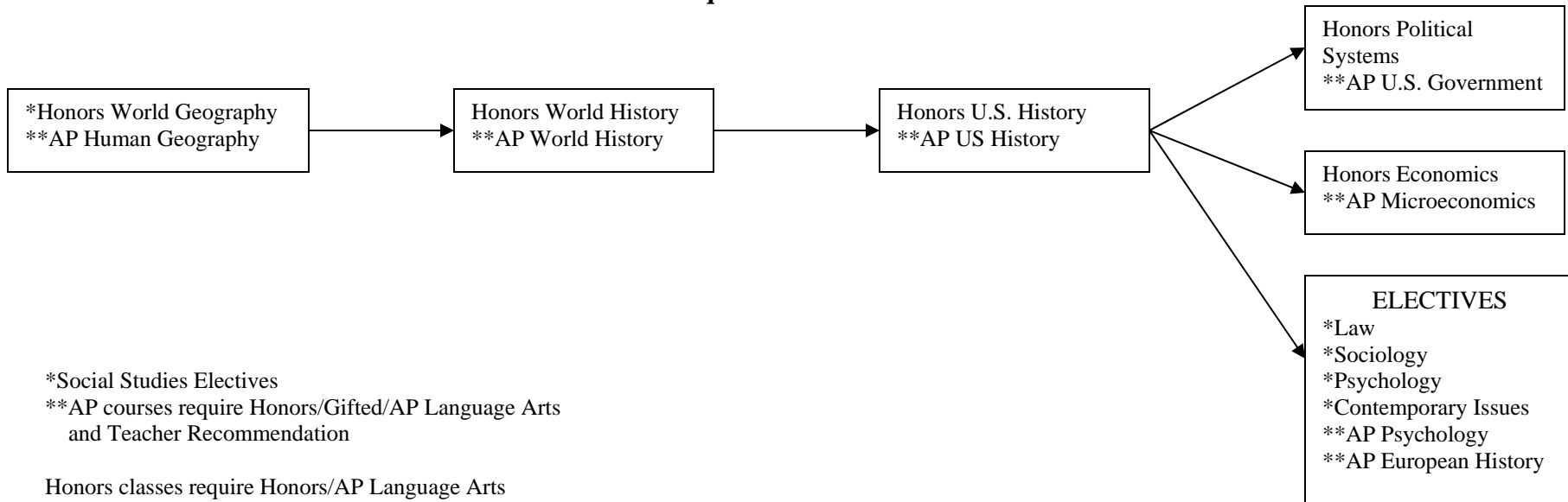
