- This scholarship is open to all graduating seniors
- Applicants must be actively involved in volunteer work in the community and or a local church and provide documentation from the volunteer sponsor.
- A typewritten essay (no more than 3 pages) on:

**“Why the following traits are essential to a well rounded & successful individual”**

**\* Demonstration of leadership & citizenship skills**

**\* Importance of faith & good moral character in daily life**

**\*The importance of mind, body & spirit working together.**

A panel of four CHHS staff members will be selected to read each essay submitted and determine the recipient, which will be presented during Senior Week.

**DEADLINE:** Essay and required documentation must be returned to Ms. Martin in the Guidance Office no later than April 14, 2009.
