

Collins Hill Math Department Policies

HOMEWORK

Homework is essential to success in math. All math teachers assign homework as a means for their students to practice and review important skills that are taught in class. Students are expected to complete these assignments on a daily basis. At their discretion, individual teachers may use a variety of means to assess homework. Some of these assessment methods may include (but are not limited to): homework quizzes, notebook checks, and collecting assignments to be graded for accuracy.

CALCULATORS

All students will be using a calculator in math. It is the responsibility of the student to bring his/her calculator to class on a daily basis. However, mental math is also an important skill that we emphasize. Therefore, there will be times when students will not be allowed to use a calculator. Teachers will make students aware of these times.

LATE WORK

It is math department policy that no late work will be accepted (daily category, 20%), unless the work is late because of an excused absence. Individual teachers may have their own policies regarding make-up work.

Extra Help Opportunities

When seeking extra help or tutoring, students should arrive with book/notes/pencil/paper/assignment. They should be prepared to ask questions and be prepared to indicate what concepts they need help with.

Classroom Teacher Extra help

Teachers have individual schedules for extra help. These sessions are typically in the morning and/or after school. Teachers will inform students as to their availability.

Advisement Class Period

Students have 28 minutes each day in advisement. This time should be used wisely. Students may work on homework and/or work with a peer on assignments.

Advisement Tutoring

Teachers/Advisement teachers can sign students up for tutoring during their advisement class. There are 10 slots per advisement period available for tutoring on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. The Tutoring is done with seniors that have been assigned to a Tutoring Center. These seniors work with the students on organizational skills and will help answer questions that students might have on particular assignments. The tutors work with all subject areas and with all grade levels of students.

Tutoring is available on Tuesday Mornings from 6:45 - 7:05 and on Thursday Afternoons from 2:25 - 3:25. Students must sign up in advance so that tutors will be available. Sign up and tutoring take place in room 3.116.
